- To carry out all tasks as a professional tradesperson.

- Instruct Apprentices in correct methods and procedures to carry out tasks. Exercise control over Apprentices.
- Adequately protect customer's surfaces and property preventing damage. Clean work areas on completion of job.
- Complete weekly time sheet for presentation to Supervisor.
- Maintain Company vehicles in good order and drive courteously and in accordance with the Road Traffic Ordinance.
- Observe all Occupational Safety and Health procedures.
- Wear the Company's uniform that has been issued. Maintain a neat dress standard.
- Ensure glazing is carried out in accordance with relevant standards and codes. If in doubt ,consult with Supervisor.
- Provide comprehensive tool kit which is maintained in good order to complete all tasks.

- Follow instructions for care and use of chemicals which are issued on Material Safety Data Sheets.
- Observe all work procedures which have been issued by the Company.
